



## REV UP VOTING OUTREACH GRANT

### *Grant Agreement with REV UP Voting Coalitions and Partners*

This document serves as a Grant Agreement between the American Association of People with Disabilities (AAPD), located at 2020 Pennsylvania Ave., Mailbox 263, Washington DC 20006 and [insert REV UP Coalition or Partner Name], the Grantee, located at [insert REV UP Coalition or Partner Address]. The agreement includes a \$2,000 grant for work related to civic engagement and voting rights advocacy during the contract term.

#### **Purpose of Grant:**

The purpose of this Grant Agreement is to support projects and initiatives to advance the Disability Vote in the state of [insert REV UP Coalition or Partner State]. The REV UP network is composed of state and local coalitions that work to advance the Disability Vote. REV UP's mission is to foster civic engagement and protect the voting rights of Americans with disabilities. In 2020, there was a voting gap of 7% between people with and without disabilities. Each REV UP Voting Coalition is critical to mobilizing and activating the power of the Disability Vote in their state.

#### **Possible Grant Activities:**

- Sending a hard copy flyer or postcard around the disability vote to community members.
- Calling consumers to remind them to register to vote and direct them to how they can register, whether by mail, online, or in person.
- Hosting voter registration drives, in-person or virtually.
- Providing accurate information on voter registration deadlines and state or county elections offices.
- Sending newsletters dedicated to voting registration and education for voters and potential voters in their state with FAQs and links to voting resources.
- Conducting virtual trainings and meetings on the importance of the disability vote, the voting rights of voters with disabilities, the voting process, and more.
- Adding information on voting and the disability vote on their website.
- Collaborating with other voting organizations to reach voters with disabilities.
- Adding voting information on all of their social media sites and posting the AAPD REV UP online voter registration portal (when it becomes available) on all social media sites.

- Adding the AAPD REV UP online voter registration portal (or another voter registration portal) in all newsletters and on their website.
- Covering costs for advertising for events or other key information related to the disability.
- Covering costs for accommodations for events or meetings.

Please note that these possible grant activities are not all required to receive a grant. You may apply to use the grant for other activities not listed that would grow the power of the disability vote in your community.

**Reporting Requirements:**

By the end of January 2022, Grantees will provide a midterm written report including analytics to the material/activities that promoted the Disability Vote and an accounting of the budget. The Grantee will provide a final report with the same information as the midterm report by the end of July 2022. Some reporting data may include social media engagement, numbers of contacts reached with voting material, number and types of events held, and more.

Please note that new REV UP coalitions receiving or applying for the REV UP Voter Outreach Grant may also apply for the REV UP Start Up Grant.
